NOTICE OF INTENDED STRIKE ACTION: PUBLIC SERVICE UNIONS

1. DPSA's letter 1/10/1 dated 9 September 2004 in respect of the above matter has reference.
2. Please note that public service trade unions working together with the recognised public service trade unions to the PSCBC that have served both the employer and the PSCBC with a notice to embark on strike action on 16 September 2004 shall be deemed to have been included in the said notice. For example, in the event where NEHAWU is working together with PAWUSA in the collective bargaining processes of the PSCBC, a notice issued by NEHAWU for purposes of this strike shall be construed to be inclusive of PAWUSA.
3. The trade union working together arrangement in the public service is as follows:
 - (a) DENOSA acting together with SAMA as DENOSA.
 - (b) HOSPERSA, NUPSAW and NATU acting together as HOSPERSA/NUPSAW/NATU.
 - (c) NEHAWU acting together with PAWUSA as NEHAWU.
 - (d) PSA acting together with UNIPSA and NPSWU as PSA.
 - (e) POPCRU acting together with SASAWU and SADNU as POPCRU; and
 - (f) APEK, CTPA, ITUSA, NUE, OFSATA, PEU, SAOU, SAUVSE and USAPE acting together as NAPTOSA.
4. Hoping that you will find this in order.
