**WAGE UPDATE: REPORT 2**

Another round of wage negotiations took place at the Public Service Coordinating Bargaining Council on Tuesday, 25 May 2010.

The session concluded with the parties recording the following positions:


The Employer shifted from 5.3% to 6.2% effective on 1 July 2010.

Labour has revised its demand for a salary adjustment to 9.5% effective on 1 April 2010. They have retained their demand for a housing allowance of R1650. The parties agreed to setup a two aside task team to deal with the issues of medical aid which will

report back to Council on 28 May 2010. Labour have indicated that they will provide a consolidated revised position on all aspects of their demands in order for the Employer to seek a comprehensive revised mandate on its offer.

Accordingly the parties will reconvene at the PSCBC on 28 May 2010 at 10h00.
