**SPECIAL DAILY ALLOWANCE: BURUNDI**

The Minister for the Public Service and Administration has, in terms of section 3(3) of the Public Service Act, 1994, as amended, read with Part V/E.2(a) of the Public Service Regulations, 2001, made a determination that with effect from 1 December 2003, the special daily allowances for official visits to Burundi be revised as contained in the attached Annexure.
