

RECOGNITION OF SERVICE OF THE FORMER NON-STATUTORY FORCES PENSIONABLE SERVICE IN THE GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES PENSION (GEPF)

1. DPSA circular dated 25 May 2007 and the attached circular of the Government Employees Pension Fund (GEPF) dated 16 April 2008 on Non-Statutory Forces (NSF) has reference.
2. Kindly note that the Board of Trustees of the GEPF has in terms of Rule 10.6(a) of the Government Employees Pension Law, 1996, as amended, extended the cut-off date for recognition of service of the former NSF as indicate below:
 - 2.1. The date for active members contributing to the GEPF has been extended to 31 March 2009.
 - 2.2. The date for members that have exited the GEPF has been extended to 31 March 2010.
3. Departments are urged to strictly adhere to these dates and submit particulars of affected individuals without delay as this is the last extension of the cut-off date. When submitting the required information to the GEPF, departments are reminded to follow the process contained in circular 1/6/22/P dated 13 January 2005 available on the dpsa website: www.dpsa.gov.za.


- The date for **active members** contributing to the GEPF has been extended to **31 March 2009**.
