

**RESETTLEMENT EXPENDITURE: NEW SCHOOL BOOKS, UNIFORMS AND
RELATED COSTS**

1. Based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI): Clothing and Footwear as on 1 January 2010, the Minister for the Public Service and Administration has determined that the amount payable to compensate transferred employees for new school books, uniforms and related costs, be increased from R 987.00 to R 990.00 with effect from 1 April 2010. Please refer to the attached table.
2. National Treasury has granted approval under reference SM 5P in terms of section 5(3) of the Public Service Act, 1994, as amended, for the implementation of the revised tariffs. However, the resulting additional expenditure incurred as a result of this approval will have to be met from existing budgets of affected departments.
