- ✓ The BRICS International Youth Contest on Social Anti-Corruption is an annual programme; Themed “Together Against Corruption!”
- ✓ The project involves young people between **14 and 35** years of age designing a poster or develop a video to raise awareness and express their attitudes towards corruption;
- ✓ The competition goals are mostly to attract young people to participate in the corruption prevention and to develop and use social anti-corruption advertising to prevent corrupt practices;
- ✓ The contest runs from **01 June and 01 October; and**

- ✓ Entries are submitted to [www.anticorruption.life](http://www.anticorruption.life)
- ✓ Ten videos and ten posters will be shortlisted after the closing date on 01 October 2021.
- ✓ The project is divided into two Chapters, the first Chapter of the contest, which is at the national level, represents the semi-finals
- ✓ Out of the ten shortlisted entries from both categories, the top three will be selected as winners for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places.
- ✓ The winners of the 1<sup>st</sup> places from both categories will advance to the finals (International Chapter) in Moscow, Russia, where overall winners of the contest will be announced in 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place.
