PSCBC RESOLUTION 1 OF 2015 – AGREEMENT ON THE REVIEW OF EXISTING OUTSOURCING AND AGENTISATION PRACTICES WITHIN THE PUBLIC SERVICE AND CONDUCTING AN INDEPENDENT IMPACT STUDY ON THE PRINCIPLES OF DECENT WORK

On 10 February 2015, parties in the PSCBC signed PSCBC Resolution 1 of 2015 which is an agreement on “The Review of Existing Outsourcing and Agentisation Practices within the Public Service and Conducting an Independent Impact Study on the Principles of Decent Work”.

Parties further resolved that a service provider be appointed under the auspices of the PSCBC in order to give effect to this agreement.

Accordingly, REGEN Group was appointed by the PSCBC to conduct research on the review of existing outsourcing and agentisation practices among selected national and provincial departments, and targets the following groups:

- a. Procurement officers and managers;
- b. Shop stewards;
- c. Soft skills employees; and
- d. Service providers outsourcing soft skills.

The findings of the research will be tabled at council and Heads of Department will be kept abreast accordingly.

Heads of national and provincial departments are therefore requested to cooperate with the REGEN Group in the event that their respective departments have been selected as one of the sites where the research will be conducted.
