Mr A P van der Westhuizen (DA) to ask the Minister of Public Service and Administration:

(a) When can we expect the National School of Government to be fully operational, (b) how many courses does it currently offer and (c) how many civil servants have enrolled for courses in 2015?

REPLY

- (a) The National School of Government has being operational since it was launched in October 2013.Motivation for additional funding has been submitted to the National Treasury. This additional funding will enable the National School of Government to implement its Business Plan, which will in turn lead to the National School of Government to be fully operational.
- (b) The National School of Government currently offers a total of 146 courses and programmes, covering the training streams of Leadership, Management, Administration and Induction.
- (c) The National School of Government has not received new civil servants enrolment for 2015 at this stage. However, learners who have enrolled in 2014 will continue with their studies in 2015.

As a general trend, departments only enroll their employees for training in the year in which they will attend this training
