

RESOLUTION NO. 4 OF 1999

INCREASE IN PENSIONABLE SERVICE FOR SELECTED DWAF EMPLOYEES

1 Aims

The PSCBC allocates a maximum of R130 million from the funds provided under Paragraph 7 of Resolution 7 of 1998 to increase the pensionable service of former casual workers employed in the Department of Water Affairs and Forestry (DWAF) who accept a transfer to a private company or a VSP, or goes on pension, under an agreement in the DWAF negotiations chamber.

2 Scope

2.1 This agreement applies to the employer and employees:

- (a) who are employed by the State, and
- (b) who fall within the registered scope of the PSCBC.

3 Eligibility

3.1 This agreement shall improve pensionable service for former casual employees employed by the DWAF, who

- (a) accept a transfer to a private company and/or a VSP, or goes on pension, as provided in a collective agreement signed in the DWAF negotiations chamber, or
- (b) applied for a VSP after December 1, 1998.

4 Increase in pensionable service

The GEFP shall increase the pensionable service of an eligible employee to equal the pensionable service the employee would have had if she or he had been a permanent employee.

5 General

5.1 The agreement reflects the special circumstances prevailing at DWAF.

5.2 Other allocations under Paragraph 7 of Agreement 7 of 1998 will be dealt with in terms of the merits of the case.

6 Date of implementation

This agreement shall, in respect of parties and non-parties, come into operation on the date it is signed in the PSCBC (10 February 1999).
