



RESOLUTION NO 3 OF 2005

AMENDMENT TO PART XXVIII OF RESOLUTION 3 OF 1999: LONG SERVICE AWARD

Scope

1. This agreement binds:
 - (a) the employer;
 - (b) the employees of the employer who are members of the trade union parties to this agreement; and
 - (c) the employees of the employer who are not members of any trade union party to this agreement, but who fall within the registered scope of Council.

Objective

2. The objective of this resolution is to amend Part XXVIII of PSCBC Resolution 3 of 1999, as amended by Resolution 6 of 2003.

Agreement

3. The parties to the Public Service Co-ordinating Bargaining Council (PSCBC) hereby agree to amend clause 4.1 of Part XXVIII of Resolution 3 of 1999, as amended by Resolution 6 of 2003, retrospectively with effect from 01 July 1999 by deleting the words “if the employee does not work for the SANDF, the SAPS or Correctional Services” and by inserting a new clause 5 to read as follows:


“The provisions of this Part do not apply to employees that are members of the SANDF or the SAPS.”

General Provisions






4. No amendments to this agreement shall be in force or effect unless reduced to writing and signed by all parties concerned.
5. The representatives of all relevant parties undertake to take all reasonable steps necessary to ensure the implementation of this agreement.
6. If there is a dispute about the interpretation or application of this agreement any party may refer the matter to the Council for resolution in terms of the dispute resolution procedure of the Council.
7. This agreement shall come into effect on the date of signing.
8. The Council will monitor the implementation of this agreement.
